Create **nature prints** on paper using **Nature printing** is a very old technique working directly with plants and ink, & was used to identify medicinal plants. In contemporary times it is a simple technique to explore our surroundings - no art experience required. The project will ask to borrow the prints you make for display at The Goat can be viewed and will 'grow' over the three weeks from 15 October and ready to launch as part of the Nati Frinj Biennale.
